

Trina filled out a written statement:
During and early event in the day Cory noticed his bag of money was missing. When mentioned what would happen if his money went missing Trina became suspicious of comments. Right before arriving at District Court to drop them off with Leslie Trina questioned why all of stated cause it was full. Trina eventually searched stated cause it was full. Trina eventually searched backpack and found the bag of money. When Trina found the money ran out of the vehicle towards mom who was in the District Court waiting area.
I contacted Becky Linkford of Washoe County Child Protective Services and informed her of the situation with the children. Becky told me she has past history with the Hendersons including domestic violence, TPO's, and an assault with a deadly weapon charge in 2008.
I feel as though the minor children of Leslie and Cory are being manipulated by both parents in many ways. I feel Leslie is coaching and influencing to distance from father and gain leverage in court.
This report is an informational only and will be forwarded to CPS for review.

On October 17, 2012, I, Deputy Swanson, was assigned as a Bailiff to the 2nd Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada. At approximately 1810 hours, Deputy Wright and I had completed an inmate transport to the Washoe County Detention Facility and were heading back to District Court to complete our shift, when Deputy Wright received a phone call from Sgt. Mullen. Sgt. Mullen advised Deputy Wright dispatch was sending units (police officers) Code 3 (lights and siren) to Court Street on the report of a domestic disturbance at the Family Peace Center. Having just parked the transport van in the parking garage across from Court Street, we immediately rushed over to the scene.

Upon arrival, Deputy Wright and I were met by a white female adult (later identified as HENDERSON, LESLIE) who relayed the following:

LESLIE was at Court Street and was going to use the Family Peace Center to complete a child custody exchange between her and her ex-husband (later identified as HENDERSON, CORY). As she was waiting in the lobby, she saw her children arrive with CORY. Their mother and told LESLIE dad had threatened to kill because had taken a large sum of money from him and he found out about it. LESLIE went on to say that CORY is dealing cocaine and always has drugs and large sums of money at his home.

At this time I asked where CORY was and was told by LESLIE he was upstairs in the Family Peace Center. I received a description of what he looked like/was wearing and responded upstairs to meet with him.

Narrative I found CORY in one of the meeting rooms, standing and speaking with a civilian employee. I verified his identity by his Nevada Driver's License and asked him to have a seat. CORY was visibly agitated, as he was shaking and his voice cracked when he spoke. Furthermore, I had to ask him 3-4 times to sit down, as he did not want to, or simply didn't listen to my command because of the level of his agitation. When he finally sat down, I

advised him of why I was there and asked him his version of what had transpired in the last hour. He provided this version of the incident:	
CORY had his at his apartment as part of his regularly scheduled child visitation. The visitation was ending and he was preparing to return his kids to the Family Peace Center for the child custody exchange with LESLIE. As he was preparing to leave, he went to get his money bag, but could not find it. He searched all over his home, but to no avail. Because it was getting too close to the agreed upon exchange time, he abandoned his search, packed his kids into his truck and headed downtown. As he drove downtown, he continued to worry and wonder what happened to his money. He was talking to his	
girlfriend (who was with him and his kids in the truck, identified as BESEL, TRINA) and discussing where his money bag might be. CORY then questioned about the money bag. answers were vague and concerning, so CORY opted to search backpack. Upon initial inspection, the money bag was not located. CORY then asked again if the knew where the money bag was and again got a response that left CORY believing knew more than was willing to admit. TRINA searched the backpack at this point and located	
CORY became very upset and began yelling at the demanding explain herself. They arrived at Council Street and before he could question further, got out of the truck, ran across the street and immediately met LESLIE. CORY then exited the truck and responded across the street with their attempting to continue questioning about why took his money. However, LESLIE had taken upstairs to the Family Pear Center and would not allow CORY to see or question further. At that point, CORY and LESLIE were separated by civilians and that was his last contact with LESLIE and	Ce
I asked CORY how much money was in the money bag, which he was gripping very tightly in his hands. He advised approximately \$8000. I then asked him why he kept so much money in a money bag, on his person. CORY never directly answered, instead saying, "I always carry this much money on me." He then clarified a bit, explaining he pays in cash for everything and doesn't believe in having credit cards or debt. I then asked what it was he did for a living to be able to carry around that much cash at any given time and he said he was a Mortgag Banker that still did quite well for himself through this economic downturn. CORY had calmed down a bit and asked if he could speak with his as he wanted to know why took his money, as he had no idea why would do this. I asked CORY if he, upon realizing had taken his money, threatened in any way. CORY said he didn't think so, but because he was so angry, he doesn't remember exactly what he said.	t ge
Reno Police had also responded to the civil disturbance and met with me upstairs. They had further interviewed LESLIE and and learned that LESLIE (according to had told to steal CORY's money during visit because CORY is behind on child support and supposedly lies about his income. has stolen money from CORY before in the amount of approximately \$1300. Again, admitted had done this at the request of LESLIE, to which LESLIE denies the allegation.	
I asked CORY if he had ever noticed money missing prior to this incident, and he advised \$5-\$10, here and there. I then asked CORY if he wanted to pursue criminal charges against his for stealing his money and he advised he did not; that he just wanted to know why she did it. It was explained to CORY that have stolen the money at the request of LESLIE as a way to prove he has the money to pay child support. COF advised he is current on child support, with the exception of this month and feels this is simply LESLIE's way of manipulating the divorce proceedings and child support payments.	3
Based on the information obtained, it appears the only crime committed was the admitted theft of the \$8000 from CORY by However, CORY did not wish to pursue criminal charges against his Furthermore, the allegations of violent threats by CORY to were unfounded, as neither CORY, nor ever admitted this occurred.	
Regarding the \$8000 CORY carries with him, "at any given time," it appears CORY may be hiding his wealth from his bank accounts in an attempt to lower his overall income for the purposes of paying child support	t.

It was explained to CORY it behooves him to not be deceitful with regards to divorce or child custody proceedings,

as it may be detrimental to his outcome.

A written statement regarding the facts of this incident was obtained from CORY and TRINA and provided to Deputy Littlefield.

Sgt. Stahl was on scene and apprised of the facts and circumstances surrounding this event.



On October 17, 2012, I, Deputy Wright, was assigned to District Court as a Bailiff for the Honorable Judge Doherty. At approximately 1810 hours, Deputy Swanson and I had completed an inmate transport to the Washoe County Detention Facility. As we were arriving back to District Court to park the patrol vehicle, I received a phone call from Sergeant Mullen. Sgt Mullen asked me what was taking place at the Peace Center at advised him that I had not heard any radio traffic of any situations and was not aware of anything that might be taking place at the Peace Center. He informed me that he had received a phone call from a fellow Deputy who had asked him if he was aware that Deputies were being dispatched to the Peace Center, Code 3 (lights and sirens). Het him know we would be in route and that I would brief him of the situation when I knew more.

Upon arrival, Deputy Swanson and I were met by a white female adult (later identified as HENDERSON, LESLIE) who relayed the following:

LESLIE was at Court Street where she was court ordered to use the Family Peace Center for her children's exchanges twice a week with her now ex-husband (later identified as HENDERSON, CORY). As she was waiting in the lobby she saw her children arrive with CORY. Their out of his truck and ran toward the entrance of the Courthouse. When ERIN met up with was crying and saying, "dad's going to hurt me." LESLIE immediately took her upstairs to the "safe zone" (the Family Peace Center room).

LESLIE stated to me that when she asked her was because had taken fathers money bag. Both LESLIE and believed there to be at least \$8,000-\$13,000 cash in the bag. LESLIE believes that CORY is a cocaine dealer and that is the reason that he always has a large amount of cash on him. When I asked if had taken the bag of money stated, "yes my mom told me to." LESLIE informed Deputy Swanson that CORY was still in the building and that she believed he was on the second floor in the Family Peace Center. Deputy Swanson went upstairs to interview CORY while I stayed with LESLIE and

I asked if a father had laid hands on before or after had exited his truck? I stated he had not that was just afraid he might try to hurt because he was so mad at for attempting to take his money bag.
Deputy Littlefield arrived a few minutes later and gave all of the parties involved statement forms to fill out. Sgt Stahl arrived on scene along with two Reno Police Officers. When it was determined that CORY did not wish to press Larceny charges against the two Reno officers left the scene. An adult female approached me near the entrance and said her name was, BESEL, TRINA, the girlfriend of CORY. She stated she had information as to what had taken place and wished to also fill out a statement form. TRINA was given a statement form which she filled out in CORY'S truck parked in front of the building.
Deputy Littlefield ran a wants and warrants check on LESLIE and found a Temporary Protection Order that had yet to be served on her. Littlefield filled out the proper form and served LESLIE with the T.P.O.
After all of the statement forms were collected by Deputy Littlefield, it was determined that since CORY did not wish to press charges against that no criminal charges would be pursued.
Cory exited the building. After Cory and Trina drove away Littlefield told LESLIE she could leave with

ORDER AFTER HEARING REGARDING EX PARTE MOTION

This matter came before the Court on July 12, 2016, for a hearing on Ms. Henderson's Ex Parte Emergency Motion Regarding Children, filed June 23, 2016. Plaintiff Leslie Henderson was present representing herself. Defendant Cory Henderson was present and represented by Melissa L. Exline, Esq. Ms. Exline objected to Ms. Henderson's witness based upon non-disclosure of the witness. Based upon the sworn testimony and stipulations of the parties, pleadings on file in this matter, and good cause appearing, this Court finds and orders as follows.

Findings of Fact

The parties are parents to two children, namely, Henderson, born and Henderson, born An Order Following January 23, 2013

Hearing granted the parties joint legal custody with primary physical custody to Ms. Henderson. Ms. Henderson testified that she filed a police report on behalf of parties' because alleged that Mr. Henderson pulled a gun on and a

Ms. Henderson indicated she has a trip to France planned with from July 20, 2016 to July 29, 2016. Ms. Henderson agreed to cancel the trip to allow participate in football and Mr. Henderson agreed to reimburse the trip cost to Ms. Henderson in the amount of \$179.

Rather than having a contested hearing on the two pending motions in this case, the parties stipulated to having a settlement conference.

ORDER

- 1. The parties shall continue to have joint legal custody of the minor children.
- 2. Ms. Henderson shall have primary physical custody of Mr. Henderson shall not have visitation with unless recommended by the therapist.
- 3. Mr. Henderson shall have primary physical custody of as long as all of his firearms are removed from his home. Ms. Henderson shall have visitation with every other weekend and every Wednesday.
- 4. Ms. Henderson shall look into victim's assistance funds to pay for therapy. Should no assistance be available, shall be placed in therapy through insurance. If the insurance does not cover the prior therapist, Dori Orlich, shall

utilize a different therapist. Mr. Henderson shall reimburse Ms. Henderson \$179 for 5. trip to France. 6. Neither party shall discuss any custody issues with the minor children. 
