**Case assignment:**

On 11/8/2022, [REDACTED] tasked me with the following investigation. He advised yesterday he was informed by [REDACTED] of an incident that occurred in Reno, Nevada, involving City of Reno Mayor, Hillary SCHIEVE.

SCHIEVE took her vehicle to [REDACTED] as she is acquainted to the owner, [REDACTED]. The vehicle was put up on a lift and an unknown, small black box was located. The box was attached magnetically to the vehicle frame near the spare tire. The box was removed and opened. The box contained what appeared to be a tracking device.

After the device was located, Reno Police Department was informed of the incident. Ultimately, it was decided for Sparks Police Department to investigate the origins of the device and who was responsible for placing it on SCHIEVE's vehicle. I requested [REDACTED] to assist with the investigation.

[REDACTED] was tasked with forensic analysis of the device, while I was assigned lead in the investigation. [REDACTED] provided me with photographs he had received from [REDACTED]. The photographs were of the device, where it was located, and a screenshot the device associated with a company called Family 1st. The

photographs were uploaded to Evidence.com.

**Authorship of Subpoena:**

██████████ informed me the device appeared to be associated to the company, Family 1st, and appeared to be associated with Verizon. ██████████ authored and sent subpoenas to both of the companies requesting for records. ██████████ communicated with Family 1st and learned the device was not a part of their network. Family 1st provided ██████████ with information of a sister company, which ██████████ reached out to. The device appears to be sold on more than one platform.

**SIM Card Analysis:**

██████████ informed me the device has a SIM card. ██████████ downloaded the SIM card and discovered the card to be attached to the phone number ██████████. Furthermore, the SIM card was from AT&T. ██████████ then authored a subpoena for AT&T for records.

**Device owner identification:**

On 11/9/2022, ██████████ informed me he received information from the sister company of Family 1st concerning the identification of the person who purchased the tracker, as well as data. ██████████ informed me the person who purchased the tracker was identified as David MCNEELY. Subsequent research of MCNEELY discovered he is the owner of "5 Alpha Industries", a private investigation firm. The email listed is ██████████ and the phone number listed is ██████████. Research on the phone number comes back to David MCNEELY of ██████████.

**Criminal history checks of MCNEELY:**

Criminal history checks were conducted by SPD Dispatch on 11/10/2022 at my request. ██████████

**Interview with MCNEELY:**

On 11/16/2022, ██████████ and I contacted MCNEELY at his residence located ██████████. MCNEELY agreed to speak with us and welcomed us into his residence. The following is a synopsis of the information obtained during the interview, and not meant to be verbatim.

MCNEELY advised he was assigned to ██████████ (an undercover narcotics task force for twenty-two years). He said he has been a private investigator since 2015. He does not have any employees and the majority of his records are held digitally. He advised he uses a wide range of methods in his investigations as long as they are within the confines of the law. He is certified as a private investigator through the State of Nevada and provided me with his certification card. He advised he does private investigations for sexual assaults, missing persons, infidelity and a broad range of investigations.

I informed MCNEELY of the discovery of the tracker on Hillary SCHIEVE's vehicle and how we were able to identify where the tracker came from. MCNEELY said there is no threat to the Mayor. He advised the intent behind the investigation was not to cause harm to anyone. He advised he was not able to provide the name of the client without a subpoena signed by a judge. MCNEELY expressed liability concerns if he were to divulge the information. He advised the motive behind the investigation was political. MCNEELY advised there were allegations which he was not going to divulge. He said his investigation completely unfounded the allegation and this was told to the client. MCNEELY advised he understands if he was still operating as a law enforcement officer, he would need a search warrant but as a private investigator, he only needs a tracker.

MCNEELY advised the tracker was on the vehicle less than a month. MCNEELY said the battery life will vary depending on the activity of the tracker (as it is motion detected). MCNEELY advised the tracker was used on multiple different vehicles. He advised he often will set the tracker and not recover it because they are inexpensive. MCNEELY advised the extent of the investigation was utilizing the electronic tracker to look at "possible areas" where SCHIEVE was alleged to have been frequenting. No other surveillance methods were utilized.

**Interview with SCHIEVE:**

On 11/17/2022, myself [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] interviewed Hillary SCHIEVE at the SPD detectives conference room. The following is a synopsis of the information obtained during the interview. For full details, please see audio and video recordings.

SCHIEVE provided an overview of how the investigation began. She described strange vehicles were appearing outside of her home late at night (3-4 A.M). She also mentioned she felt like she was being followed by cars as she was traveling. She said it was campaign season and strange messages were sent to her on social media.

Her vehicle was leaking oil and she took it to the dealership where she bought the car. She said her girlfriend owns the dealership. While servicing the vehicle, the tracker was located. Her vehicle is a [REDACTED] SCHIEVE described the suspicious vehicle as a [REDACTED]. She showed me a photograph which appeared to be a [REDACTED] similar to a [REDACTED] in color.

She described her driveway as connected directly to the sidewalk. She said the street is dark and there is a lot of activity on the other end of the street. She described incidents in the past involving BLM when people would yell at her residence while driving by. She described her awareness being very high because of the suspicious activity.

Next, [REDACTED] and I explained what the investigation had uncovered in terms of the origins and activity regarding the tracking device. We explained that no criminal element had been established with the use of the tracker. I explained the private investigator was hired to investigate an allegation. The private investigator told us the allegation was determined to be false as a result of the investigation.

SCHIEVE expressed she lived a very boring life, and she was very disturbed by the fact someone placed a tracker on her vehicle. [REDACTED] and I explained the use of the tracker was not illegal for a private citizen. We explained that the laws in Nevada do not prohibit a private citizen (or in this case, a private investigator) from using electronic tracking devices.

SCHIEVE said she believed Robert BEADLES is responsible for hiring the investigator because he has had her on his website and has spent millions of dollars trying to get certain candidates elected. She described a website where there are posts about her, and he is very wealthy, which is why she believes he may be behind the incident.

SCHIEVE asked if the private investigator was here. She talked about how BEADLES has offered rewards for anyone who assists with leading to the arrest of elected officials, and she looked at reports and found out that [REDACTED] was involved with BEADLES. We confirmed the investigator, David MCNEELY, is located in Reno and we had not found any connection to BEADLES or [REDACTED] explained it is possible for [REDACTED] and MCNEELY [REDACTED]

SCHIEVE advised she was contemplating contacting the attorney general in reference to the investigation. We spoke about how law enforcement used to not need a search warrant to place an electronic tracking device, but this changed in recent years.

We advised SCHIEVE that the investigation was solely electronic tracking, and no other methods were used, according to MCNEELY.

She expressed how she felt it was wrong for someone to invade her privacy in this manner and expressed she would be following up the incident in different ways. She was provided with my contact information.

## Narrative

### Evidence:

KLD-1 black GPS tracker model [REDACTED] and IMEI number [REDACTED] inside of a black plastic case with magnets on it.

### Details of Supplement:

On November 8, 2022, at approximately 8:30 a.m., I was assigned a harassment investigation which occurred at [REDACTED] Washoe County, NV. The victim in this case was Mayor Hillary SCHIEVE. Due to a possible conflict-of-interest, Reno Police chose not to investigate and gave the case to Sparks Police. The Sparks Police Department Case number was 22-8812. The incident number was 223120221.

### Information about tracking device:

On November 8, 2022, I was given a tracking device inside of a small black plastic case with magnets on the bottom. I was told the tracker had been touched by multiple people and was not being preserved for fingerprint or DNA evidence. I have seen these type trackers in the past and believe they are used to attach to vehicles to track their movement. This tracker had some distinct markings on it as follows:

IMEI- [REDACTED]

Model: [REDACTED]

FCC contains: [REDACTED]

This information confirmed this was a GPS tracker and it was capable of connecting to cellular service and remotely viewed by an App on a cellphone or computer. I removed the two screws on the side of the tracker and removed the Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) card. This SIM card had markings on it which told me it was registered to AT&T business. The other two numbers printed onto the card were, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

I used Cellebrite to conduct a forensic extraction of the SIM card, and it showed the phone number associated with this SIM card is [REDACTED]

### Subpoena to ATT, Verizon, and Family 1st:

On November 8, 2022, I sent subpoenas to ATT for records related to the SIM card and International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) number.

When researching the tracker online, I learned that Family 1st sells a similar tracker. I sent them a subpoena to obtain subscriber information, but it was determined this tracker (IMEI number) did not belong to them.

Family 1st stated they do sell a tracker like the one we have, but this particular one did not belong to them. They have a sister company called Matrackinc.com which sells the same tracker.

On November 8, 2022, at approximately 4:15 p.m., AT&T contacted me via my cell phone and told me the IMEI and phone number does not match any subscriber information associated with the device. This is generally because the device was bought through a third party, and that party provided the AT&T SIM card.

The device showed its last activity on 11/4/2022. The AT&T caller could not tell me if there was any location data and stated it would require a search warrant to obtain any data if there was any.

I sent a subpoena to Verizon Wireless because when I looked up the model number of this tracker on the internet it showed Verizon was a common carrier for this type of device.

**Subpoena to Matrack.Inc:**

On November 9, 2022, at approximately 8:00 a.m., I sent a subpoena to Matrack.inc asking for subscriber information for the GPS tracking device.

At approximately 9:42 a.m., Matrack.inc responded with subscriber information and GPS logs. The subscriber was listed as David MCNEELY with an address of [REDACTED] and associated email of [REDACTED] with phone number of [REDACTED] and credit card in the name [REDACTED]. The credit card was through [REDACTED].

The account was activated on 3/15/2022. This was also the first dates of the GPS tracking information. The tracker was purchased from [REDACTED] shop located at [REDACTED] but this shop is now closed.

Law Enforcement systems showed phone number [REDACTED] belonged to David [REDACTED] MCNEELY with date of birth [REDACTED].

I analyzed the GPS coordinates that were provided by Matrack.inc, and it appeared the same tracker was used in different locations. The first date, it was shown near Mayor Hillary SCHIEVE'S residence was on October 12, 2022, at approximately 3:30 a.m.

The GPS tracker updated every minute and showed to leave the area of David MCNEELY'S house and travel directly to the area of Hillary SCHIEVE'S home. The tracker showed to have 100% battery life. The tracker was left on the vehicle until it was located on November 4, 2022. The battery life was at 46%.

The full excel spreadsheet of the locations from the tracker were uploaded into Evidence.com.

**Research laws:**

On November 10, 2022, I researched laws that may be applicable to this case. Tampering with a Motor Vehicle, Stalking, and Harassment. Most of these laws did not discuss electronic surveillance. The federal Stalking statute, 18 U.S. Code 2261A, stated if you intend to harass or place under surveillance with the intent to ...electronic communication system... causes, attempts to cause, or would reasonably expect to cause substantial emotional distress to a person.

To determine if this or any other crime has been committed, interviews will be conducted with Hillary SCHIEVE and David MCNEELY.

**Private Investigators Licensing Board:**

On November 10, 2022, I contacted the Private Investigators Licensing Board, and they informed me that Private Investigators are required to follow NRS 648 and NAC 648. I printed the registration work card from the website for both David MCNEELY and 5 Alpha Industries, LLC. It showed an expiration date of 6/30/2023 for the company and showed expired registration for David on 1/19/2016.
