

ORDER DENYING MOTION TO FURTHER EXPEDITE RESOLUTION

On January 12, 2024, appellant filed a motion to expedite the resolution of this appeal from district court orders refusing to change venue and dismissing the underlying election law complaint for failure to state a claim, pointing out that the primary election is five months away. This court agreed to expedite the matter to the extent that its docket allows.

On March 5, 2024, appellant filed a letter, which this court construes as a motion, *see* NRAP 27(a)(1), again pointing to the upcoming primary election and other related deadlines and seeking a decision “within

the coming week.” Having reviewed the motion, it is denied. As previously stated, this court will expedite this matter to the extent its docket allows.

It is so ORDERED.
