## STATE WIDE BALLOT QUESTIONS



**Number 1** - Amends the Nevada Constitution to remove the constitutional provisions governing the election and duties of the Board of Regents of the State University.



**Number 2** - Amends the Nevada Constitution to add and revise terms relating to persons with certain conditions for whose benefit certain public entities are supported by the State.



**Number 3** - Amends the Nevada Constitution for open primaries and ranked choice voting.



**Number 4** - Removes language authorizing the criminal punishments of slavery and involuntary servitude in both the Nevada Constitution and related Ordinance.



**Number 5** - Amends the Sale & Use Tax Act to provide an exemption from the tax for child and adult diapers.



**Number 6** - This proposes to extend the right to an abortion from the current 24 weeks to up to 9 months with no medical doctor required to be mandated in the Nevada Constitution, overriding the current law and parental rights.



**Number 7** - Amends the Nevada Constitution to provide for Voter ID.



**Number 8** - Mandates that a portion of property taxes be given to county libraries, possibly causing increased taxes.
